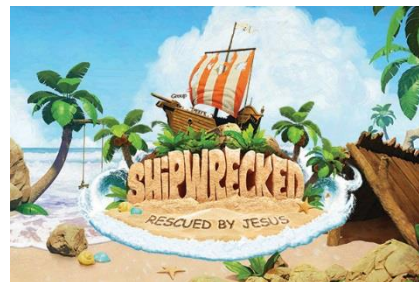
INK CARTRIDGES AND BATTERIES
